## FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST

I refer to your Freedom on Information Request of 16 July 2015 which is being dealt with as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

You requested the following:

I am enquiring as to whether your organisation holds photographs of:

- (I) the meeting between the King of Siam and W.G.Armstrong at the Elswick, Newcastle upon Tyne premises of Armstrong, Mitchell and Co in 1892?
- (II) the dinner hosted by W.G.Armstrong for Nikola Tesla at the Banqueting Hall, Jesmond Dene Road, Newcastle upon Tyne in spring 1892?

Any other documentation held, such as correspondence arranging or thanking W.G.Armstrong would also be of interest.

Documents held in the Archives are exempt from Freedom of Information Act 2000 because they're already publicly available (section 21 FOIA).

Tyne & Wear Archives & Museums have checked our catalogue (<a href="http://www.tyneandweararchives.org.uk/DServe2/dserve.exe?dsqApp=Archive&dsqDb">http://www.tyneandweararchives.org.uk/DServe2/dserve.exe?dsqApp=Archive&dsqDb</a> = Catalog&dsqCmd=Search.tcl) and found no specific reference to the meeting/dinner using the search references Siam and Nikola Tesla.

The minutes can be viewed in the searchroom at Discovery Museum during our normal opening hours (Tues-Fri, 10-4), otherwise we offer a paid research service. A search of the archives records can be requested by email to: archives@twmuseums.org.uk.
