## Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) Request – 200124021

Thank you for your request dated 24 January 2020, in which you asked for the following information from the Ministry of Justice (MoJ):

"Please can you tell me the cost of a PIP adjournment? If you cannot give me the full amount please let me know the salary of the panel, to be used in an NVQ project for operational delivery"

Your request has been handled under the FOIA.

I can confirm that the MoJ holds some of the information that you have requested. However, the information is exempt from disclosure under section 21 of the FOIA, because it is reasonably accessible to you. The information can be accessed via the following link(s)
