Freedom of Information Act 2000

I refer to your request dated 12 July 2012, following on from my reply to you of the same date. This request has been treated as a fresh request under the Freedom of Information Act and given the new reference above.

Your follow up request was for details of HM Revenue and Customs' (HMRC) estate Private Finance Initiative (PFI) providers.

The vast majority of HMRC's estate is covered by the national Strategic Transfer of the Estate to the Private Sector (STEPS) PFI contract with Mapeley STEPS Contractor Ltd. In addition, Newcastle Estate Partnership provides accommodation at a stand alone site in Jarrow and in large multi-building sites in Newcastle and Washington. London and Regional provides stand alone offices in Edinburgh, Glasgow, Salford and Stockport, and Bootle PFI Solutions Ltd and Exchequer Partnership (No2) each provide a single site in Bootle and London respectively.
