I want to ensure that the monitoring equipment is installed well in advance of any scheme being introduced, to ensure there is sufficient "before data" to undertake a meaningful evaluation of the scheme's impact.

## Air Quality:

• to complement the existing <u>air quality network</u>, diffusion tubes were installed on 31 March 2021

## Road users:

- to complement the existing <u>Vivacity Lab multimodal sensors</u> additional VL sensors were installed in February 2021.
- To complement the existing network of <u>Automatic Traffic Counters</u>, additional Automatic Traffic Counters and Automatic Cycle Counters are to be installed under a contract scheduled to commence in July 2021.
