

0210/15 Land off Kingfisher Drive, Great Blakenham has a legal agreement dated 9 November 2015 which, due to viability considerations, provided for the following contributions and infrastructure provision:

- Affordable Housing Provision
- Early years Contribution £12,181.00 (subject to indexation)
- Highways Contribution £50,000.00 (subject to indexation)
- Primary School Contribution £60,905.00 (subject to indexation)
- Provision of Open Space and ongoing maintenance

The council also placed £97,475 to a reserve account to spend in line with the Open Space and Social Infrastructure Policy.

- The Affordable Housing Units have been provided.
- The Early Years contribution of £12,999.13 was paid to Suffolk County Council 30 December 2016, Suffolk County Council would need to provide specific allocation and spend data to you by a separate request.
- The Highways Contribution of £53,358.21 was paid to Suffolk County Council 30 December 2016 - The Zebra Crossing was provided and Suffolk County Council would need to provide specific allocation and spend data to you by a separate FOI request made to direct to them.
- The Primary School Contribution of £64,995.63 was paid to Suffolk County Council 30 December 2016. Suffolk County Council would need to provide specific allocation and spend data to you by a separate FOI request made direct to them.
- The onsite open space was provided and is being maintained by Mid Suffolk District Council.
- There are currently a range of Open Space, Sport and Social Infrastructure Projects that are being developed by the Councils Strategic Leisure Advisor & Leisure Projects Manager which may include the following:
 1. Improvement of the sportsground at Claydon;
 2. New sports pitches and facilities at the former picnic site, Lower Crescent, Barnham;
 3. Improvements to existing built sports facilities at Claydon High School to create dual use facility;
 4. Refurbishment and works of improvement to the Parish Rooms;
 5. Great Blakenham Village Hall and its adjoining recreation ground and play areas.
