Your request has been assessed and the following information is provided in response:

Ealing have no posts with any of the above job titles.

However, we do have two members of staff employed to carry out the roles of S106/CIL monitoring although neither has an up to date role profile that reflects their current duties and responsibilities at present.

Their main role and responsibilities relate to the collection and analysis of Mayoral CIL and the monitoring of S.106 monies.

It should be noted that Ealing LPA is a CIL collecting authority on behalf of the GLA/Mayor of London and we do not currently have an LPA CIL.
