Dear Lee,

I refer to your request, where you asked:

I would like to see the plan that has been created to ensure the public is fully informed on Brexit progress. You might call this a 'Brexit Communications Plan' or words to that effect. I am essentially asking to see what you have as a documented and clear communications plan to the public.

I can confirm the Department for Exiting the European Union (DExEU) does not hold information in the manner you have requested.

There is no single document in the Department that acts as a communications plan on informing the public on the EU exit process. The Department informs the public on the EU exit process through Ministerial engagement, updates to our website, position papers also published on our website and regular updates to Parliament, whether that be in speeches or during departmental questions, both of which can be found on Hansard.

Furthermore, the Government has provided information about leaving the EU on the Plan for Britain website, I have included a link to this information below:
