Thank you for your email of 24 March where you requested the following information:

Please supply documents written in the past 2 years for the Department for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy, which mention GWP.*

We have considered your request in accordance with the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 ('the EIRs') as the information you request falls within the definition of 'environmental information' in the EIRs.

After careful examination of your request, we have interpreted this to mean documents externally written for, or commissioned by, the Department for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy, that mention GWP* over the last two years. Based on searches we have conducted, the Department for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy has not identified any information in scope of your request.

Appeals Procedure

If you are dissatisfied with the handling of your request, you have the right to ask for an internal review. Internal review requests should be submitted within two months of the date of receipt of the response to your original request and should be addressed to the Information Rights & Records Unit.
