1. How many officers working from the Sutton Coldfield Police Station specifically have responsibility for covering the area known as Badgers Bank Road (Estate)?

Four Oaks dedicated neighbourhood team has 1 sergeant, 1 constable and 2 community support officers. They are also supported by the community priority teams which have 1 sergeant and 7 officers on duty daily.

2. In the last six months and twelve months respectively, how many times have officers been called to the Badgers Bank Estate?

Between 02/10/13 and 02/10/14 there were 133 calls to Badgers Bank estate.

Between 02/04/14 and 02/10/14 there were 46 calls to Badgers Bank estate.

3. In respect of Question 2. How many of the incidents involved Anti Social Behaviour?

Between 02/10/13 and 02/10/14 - 10 of the incidents above were classified as ASB related.

Between 02/04/14 and 02/10/14 - 7 of the incidents above were classified as ASB related.

4. Do West Midlands Police via Sutton Coldfield within Birmingham North, have community development plans for the area which covers Badgers Bank Estate, if so please forward these?

Sergeant Simon Turner from the Sutton Four Oaks Neighbourhood Team has provided the following response:

We work closely with the housing association for the area to support residents and take action against identified problem addresses/occupants. There are currently no community development plans as this has not been raised as a problem location by residents or through neighbourhood tasking and levels of ASB are low. We would welcome any suggestions if there are concerns that have not been brought to police attention.
