## Request for review of the IPCC's decision under the Freedom of Information Act 2000

Your email of 18th May requesting a review has been passed to me as the IPCC's reviewing officer.

I note that you originally asked the IPCC for details of the number of FOIA requests that it had processed during each of the calendar years from 2005 to 2009 and also "all data, if held, as to the number of internal reviews that have been rejected or upheld (even partially) by the IPCC in the same years".

Mr Johnston wrote to you on 18th May to provide you with details of the number of FOIA requests processed from 2005 to 2009. However, Mr Johnston decided not to give you all of the information you requested relating to internal reviews.

Having reviewed your request and the response, I believe that a search of the IPCC's electronic records should be conducted to see if a more detailed response can be given to your request for information concerning internal reviews.

I have therefore asked Mr Johnston in the Freedom of Information team to reconsider your request as a matter of priority. Once he has done this, he or a colleague will respond to you and, if you are dissatisfied with that response, you will of course have the right to ask for review of that decision.
