- 1. The Council funds 2 Police officers under the Met Patrol Plus scheme at a cost of £124000, and benefits from a further 2 officers as a result.
- 2. The 4 officers funded through the MPP scheme work in the following areas
 - a. Domestic Abuse
 - b. Gangs
 - c. Restorative Justice (Youth Offending)
 - d. Integrated Offender Management
- 3. We run up to 15 Community Payback projects a week

Examples include:

Salisbury Hall Sports Ground-Painting changing rooms, vegetation removal to prevent rough sleeping

Low Hall Sports Ground - Clearing leaves, clearing remains of rough sleepers, painting

Leyton Jubilee Park - Clearing leaves, clearing remains of rough sleepers Langthorne Park - Cleaning, painting and clearing overgrown vegetation

Cann Hall Park - Clearing overgrown vegetation

Thomas Gamuel Park - Clearing overgrown vegetation

Friday Hall Community Centre - Litter pick and painting

Rosewood Court - Clearing shrub areas

Leyton Youth Centre - Litter pick and painting

Low Hall Depot - Litter pick

Harrow Road - Litter pick

Burnside allotments - Clear vacant plots

Leytonstone School - Painting,

Longshaw School - Painting, cleaning

4. Does Waltham Forest Council have a process for identifying and nominating projects for the Community Payback scheme? If so, please provide an outline of this process.

All projects go through the Council's waste team who decide if the scheme is acceptable, risk assessments are carried out for each project and then the work is scheduled in.
