### Dear Dr Yardley

I write in response to the above-referenced Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request submitted on 13/03/2017. Thames Valley Police has now considered this request, which for clarity, has been repeated below:

#### Request

Please supply me with a copy of all communications with reference or mention of police injury pensions or injury on duty pensions, from Mr Chris SHARP to Dr CHENG and from Chris SHARP to the national attendance management forum (NAMF) from Jan 01 2015 to present date.

Communications such as medical reports or any others containing private medical information about named individuals is not requested.

#### Response

This request is being refused under **Section 12(2)** of the FOIA.

Section 12 of the FOIA allows that public authorities do not have to comply with section 1(1) of the Act if the cost of complying would exceed the appropriate limit. In accordance with the Freedom of Information Act, this letter represents a Refusal Notice for this request.

This information, if held, would not be held in an easily retrievable format and would require a manual trawl of all records held, both paper based and electronic. As this dates back to 1<sup>st</sup> January 2015, this will exceed the appropriate 18 hour time and £450 cost limit.

## Section 16:- Further advice & assistance

Should you wish to narrow down the time frame significantly, i.e. 01/01/2017 to 31/01/2017, we may be able to assist you. However, it is likely
