FIRE SERVICE CIRCULAR NO 8/1988

POLICE AND FIREMEN'S PENSIONS

The purpose of this circular is to advise police and fire authorities of the following:

#### Public sector transfer arrangements - club schemes A.

The procedure for club scheme transfers has recently changed and the revised arrangements are explained in Annex 1. of schemes participating in the public sector transfer arrangements has been updated and the version included in Annex 2 replaces that which accompanied joint Home Office Circular No 19/1987 - Fire Service Circular No 1/1987. Authorities should continue, when in doubt, to ask this office whether there have been any further changes to the list (police: Mr M Gibbs: 01-273 3624) or (fire: Mr D Pickford: 01-273 3423).

#### В. Medical retirement

- A recent Judicial Review action has highlighted a Court of Appeal Judgement which may be relevant when the question of medical retirement is under consideration. In the Judicial Review it was held that, following a principle established in Regina .v. Kent Police Authority Ex parte Godden (1971) OB. 662, the action of a force medical officer in certifying as permanently disabled an individual in respect of whom he had previously issued a certificate of permanent disablement against which a successful appeal had been made, gave rise to an appearance of bias and amounted in the particular circumstances of the case to a breach of natural justice.
- Although both cases arose under the Police Pension Scheme, the principle would apply equally to cases under the Firemen's Scheme. Under the provisions of both schemes authorities are

required to refer medical questions to duly qualified medical practitioners. The precedent established in the Godden case is most likely to apply where a person has been retired on grounds of ill-health and has successfully appealed to a medical referee, resulting in reinstatement. If the question of permanent disablement arises again it would be advisable for the case to be referred to a different medical practitioner - i.e. not the one responsible for the earlier retirement decision.

#### Police Authorities only

- C. The Police Pensions (Amendment) Regulations 1988
- 5. Police authorities should note the introduction of the above Regulations (copy enclosed) which came into force on 1 September 1988. These allow unpaid maternity leave to reckon for pension purposes under certain circumstances whilst excluding from reckoning unpaid leave for any other purpose.
- 6. The Regulations amend Regulation F1 of the Police Pensions Regulations 1987 (the principal Regulations) to the effect that a woman police officer who returns to duty on or after 27 February 1986 at the end of a period of maternity leave will be able to count the unpaid part of that leave as pensionable service provided that she:-
  - (a) remains in the police service for a period of 6 months from the date of her return to duty; and
  - (b) pays the relevant employee pension contributions within 6 months of her return to duty or within 6 months of the coming into force of the Regulations, whichever is the later.
- 7. The appropriate sum will equal the pension contributions which would have been payable by her during the relevant period had it not been a period of unpaid maternity leave, Payment may be made by instalments or in a lump sum, according to the individual's own preference.
- 8. The sums paid will attract income tax relief provided that they do not, when aggregated with other contributions payable during the relevant tax year, exceed 15% of remuneration. This will apply whichever method of payment is adopted.
- 9. The Regulations also amend Regulation A10(2) of the principal Regulations to the effect that any payments made to reckon unpaid maternity leave are included in any award by way of repayment of aggregate pension contributions as defined in that Regulation.
- 10. Regulation F1 of the principal Regulations is further amended so that unpaid leave which is taken on or after 27 February 1986 and which is not maternity leave will not count as pensionable service, except where the person concerned ceased to serve before the coming into force of these Regulations (1 September 1988).

#### D. Commutation factors

- 11. Home Office Circular No 48/1986 introduced a supplementary list of commutation factors to cover the cases of officers who retired before age 50 with more than 25 but less than 30 years' service. The resulting lump sum could be claimed on retirement even though the pension was not available until aged 50. The Police Pensions Regulations 1987 altered the position so that, except for a transitional period, the advance payment of a commuted lump sum in respect of a pension coming into payment at age 50 is no longer possible.
- 12. As a result of the above change a further category of commutation factors is now required. The standard factors provided for commutation of immediate pensions (Home Office Circular No 116/1982) assume that the officer is not entitled to any accrued pensions increase. Where an officer has ceased to serve some time before the pension is commuted there will have been a build up of entitlement to pensions increase which would come into payment at age 55. This element should be reflected in the calculations of the commuted lump sum. The Government Actuary's Department has provided appropriate factors which are in Annex 3.

#### **General**

13. This circular has no direct cost or manpower implications. An additional copy is enclosed for information of the Chief Finance Officer or the Chief Fire Officer, as appropriate.

### Revised public sector transfer arrangements - club schemes

#### General

- 1. The revised system for public sector transfer arrangements has effect from 6 April 1988. The new arrangements are based on the use of cash equivalent transfer values in respect of the accrued pension benefits at the relevant date as defined in Social Security legislation and should be applied only in those cases where a person applies to transfer all of his accrued benefits to the new Club Scheme, with the exception of (a) additional voluntary contributions other than those which purchase added years of reckonable service within a Club Scheme, and (b) any deduction made to take account of such a payment as is described in paragraph 15 below.
- 2. The appropriate sum is calculated by use of the transfer tables at the end of this Annex which take account of the revaluation of guaranteed minimum pension benefits by up to 3% as required by law. This means that it will be necessary to obtain two guaranteed minimum pension (GMP) figures, one in respect of service up to 5 April 1988, and one in respect of service thereafter. The relevant factor should be applied to the whole of the pre 1988 GMP figure and one half of the post 1988 figure to arrive at the GMP deduction in the transfer value payment calculation.
- 3. The tables refer to a retiring age of 60. This is the age at which deferred pensions become payable in the police and fire schemes so it is applicable in the calculation of transfer values.
- 4. If a transfer to which the new arrangements could have applied was already in progress before the issue of this circular there would be no objection, provided both schemes agree, to the transfer being completed under the old arrangements.
- 5. The receiving scheme will provide credit for a fully paid-up widow's or widowers' pension irrespective of the individual's contribution record in the previous scheme. Where contributions have not been made for the full period of service in the previous scheme, for example in the case of a man or woman who did not contribute to a widow's or widower's pension until such contributions became compulsory, this may result in the person concerned being credited in the receiving scheme with less than year-for-year credit.
- 6. The revised arrangements provide for the payment of a transfer value where application is made to the new Club scheme within 12 months of joining it. Application must be made in writing to the previous scheme and may be withdrawn at any time before arrangements are made for the payment of the transfer value.
- 7. The police and firemen's pension schemes currently require application for a transfer value to be made within 6 months of

joining a new scheme, or within such longer period as the police or fire authority may allow. The Police Pensions Regulations 1987 and the Firemen's Pension Scheme Order 1973 will be amended accordingly in due course but meanwhile authorities are advised to apply the new arrangements administratively.

8. Attention is drawn to the fact that those who have joined the police and fire schemes since 6 April 1987, and who have been refused a transfer of pension rights because they were outside the previous time limit of 6 months under paragraph 7, may be eligible to benefit from the new arrangements. Authorities will wish to advise scheme members accordingly.

#### Transfers out

- 9. For the calculation of a cash equivalent transfer value under the Club arrangements, the relevant date is that provided for in Social Security legislation, ie the last day of pensionable service, or, if the application for a transfer value is made after that date, the date that the written application to transfer benefits is received by the previous scheme.
- 10. The appropriate factors, taken from the tables in force at the relevant date, should be applied to the "preserved" pension benefits at the relevant date, using the officer's age and marital status at that date. It may be necessary to uplift the benefits in accordance with Social Security legislation to the relevant date where that is later than the last day of service. An example of a transfer value calculation is attached (Example 1).
- 11. Where applicable, any National Insurance modification must be taken into account and the appropriate deduction made from the transfer value. The amount of modification should be expressed as so many pounds per year, and the relevant factor from the table should be applied to that amount.
- 12. The transfer value must be adjusted to allow for that part of the pensions increase payable on the Guaranteed Minimum Pension (GMP) which is the responsibility of the State Scheme. From 6 April 1988 the scheme will be responsible for up to the first 3% of the pensions increase payable on the GMP. Therefore, it will be necessary to obtain two GMP figures, ie the GMP in respect of service up to 5 April 1988 and that applicable to service thereafter. All revaluations up to the relevant date should be incorporated into the GMP figures. Annual GMP figures can be obtained by multiplying the weekly GMP figures by 52. The sum of the GMP in respect of service up to 5 April 1988 and one-half of the GMP in respect of service after that date should be multiplied by the appropriate transfer value factor in the tables and the resulting figure should be deducted from the transfer value.
- 13. The transfer value must then be adjusted to allow for market conditions. This is done by reference to the yield on the FT Actuaries index of British Government Index Linked Stocks of duration greater than 5 years (5% inflation assumption). The yield figure is that which is appropriate to the first working day of each calendar month, which will normally be published on

the following working day in the Financial Times. The published figure will be used in respect of all transfer values whose relevant date falls in that calendar month. The transfer value should be multiplied by the Adjustment for Market Conditions (AMC), which is obtained from the published yield figure as described in the examples at the end of this Annex, to produce the transfer value payable.

- 14. Where the accrued pension benefits include a liability to pay a GMP, that liability will be transferred to the new Club scheme. Where a contributions equivalent premium (CEP) has been paid it should be recovered if a transfer value is subsequently paid.
- 15. Where the new scheme is not contracted-out a CEP or a transfer premium should be paid, as appropriate, and an equivalent deduction made from the transfer value.
- 16. Where a transfer value is paid more than 6 months after the officer's date of application interest will not be added. Payment should be made within 12 months of the officer's application, as required by Social Security legislation.

#### Transfers in

- 17. The service credit to be offered should be calculated by applying the transfer value tables in reverse, using the same age, marital status, GMP and adjustment for market conditions as was used by the previous scheme. The pensionable pay to be used in the calculation is discussed in paragraph 19 below.
- 18. Where part of the transfer payment is withheld to pay either a CEP or a limited revaluation premium (LRP) the full calculation will have to be carried out to determine the service credit (see In all other cases, a simplified approach can be adopted provided that the full information is available from the previous scheme. Under the simplified approach the Adjustment for Market Conditions and the deduction for pensions increases on GMPs should be excluded from both the service credit calculation and the transfer amount taken into account in that calculation. (The transfer payment actually made would, of course, reflect the GMP deduction and the market adjustment.) An illustration of the simplified method is shown in example 3. The simplified approach avoids the need for AMC and GMP adjustments but, if this method is used, it is important that these adjustments are excluded from both the service credit calculation and the transfer amount used in that calculation.
- 19. The pensionable pay figure should be the same as is used by the previous scheme. Where, at the relevant date, the previous scheme has increased the preserved benefits at leaving to allow for pensions increases or GMP revaluations, the pensionable pay figure used in the service credit calculations will also have to be increased. The pensionable pay used should be the pensionable pay at leaving increased in line with the member's total accrued pension since leaving service. Where GMPs and pensions in excess of GMP are revalued separately, the pensionable pay used should increase in line with the combined total of the GMP and the excess pension.

- 20. Where the previous scheme is partially integrated with the state pension scheme, it may use an abated pensionable pay figure in the calculation of the transfer value. The gross, ie unabated, pay figure should be used to calculate the credit of appropriate benefits.

#### Commutation factors

The factor to be applied to the basic pension is taken from the normal commutation tables. For age 50 the factors are 15.00 for men and 17.25 for women. Separate factors will need to be applied to the accrued pensions increase and these are 11.80 for men and 13.95 for women.

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#### Basis of calculation

Commuted value of every f1 of basic pension given up = A+(BxC)

- A = appropriate commutation factor from the standard tables.
- B = appropriate pensions increase factor less £1.
- C = constant pensions increase factor (11.80 for men; 13.95 for women).

#### Examples

1. A man reaches age 50 and his pensions increase factor at the previous pensions increase date is 1.20. For every £1 of basic pension he therefore has £0.20 of pension increase. The commuted value of every £1 of basic pension given up would therefore be:

$$f1 \times 15.00 + f0.20 \times 11.80 = f17.36$$
