I write in connection with your request for information which was received by Derbyshire Constabulary on 23/01/2020. I note you seek access to the following information:

I request information on the stations and custody suites throughout your policing area. Can you please provide information on:

1. *Police Stations containing custody areas. Both Staffed and reserve locations.*
2. *Number of cells and detention rooms at each location.*
3. *Front Counter opening hours.*
4. *Direct contact information for the front desk or custody suite contact person.*
5. *Any stations closed since 2010.*

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request, searches were conducted within Derbyshire Constabulary to locate any relevant information. The searches located some information relevant to your request.

Decision

I have today decided to disclose the located information to you in full.

1. We have 4 custody suites within Derbyshire all of which are fully covered with CCTV monitoring. In total there are 95 Cells
2. Please see below
 - Buxton - 12 Cells, 2 Detention Rooms
 - Chesterfield - 19 Cells, 2 Detention Rooms
 - Derby (St Mary's Wharf) - 39 Cells, 4 Detention Rooms
 - Ripley (Wyatt's Way - reserve) - 15 Cells, 2 Detention Rooms
