Our 2017/2018 successes include

- ✓ **Carbon Reduction**
 - Carbon reduction of 48% per patient contact since 2007
 - Energy carbon reduction of 23% since 2013/14
 - Total carbon reduction of 3.35% since 2013/14
- ✓ **Waste and Recycling**
 - 25% of our waste was recycled in 2017/18
 - 52% was used to provide energy
 - Only 23% went to landfill
- ✓ **Transport**
 - 9 electric fleet vehicles travelled 83,845 miles without polluting out local environment
- ✓ **Capital Buildings Programme**
 - Sustainable Design Guide introduced
- ✓ **Food**
 - Healthy choices available
- ✓ **Staff Well-being**
 - Health checks introduced
 - Additional support services provided
- ✓ **Business cases**
