

Observations of the Chief Finance Officer

A procurement exercise has been carried out to invite tenders for the catering contract at the Royal Centre. The report proposes the acceptance of the tender from Kudos Hospitality which represents best value for the City Council. The tender provides annual revenue income for the City Council of [REDACTED] which has been budgeted for and levers in capital expenditure of up to [REDACTED].
