For UCAS cycle, applicants applied in the cycle given for entry in October of that year, or for deferred entry the following October.

For Year of Entry, applicants applied in the UCAS cycle of same year, or in the previous UCAS cycle for deferred entry.

Limitations of the qualifications data

Predicted A-level, unvalidated AS-level and GCSE data is as declared by the applicant on their UCAS application form. This data has not been formally verified and is therefore only as correct as stated.

Validated AS- and A-level results are supplied from UCAS after the summer examination season.

General Studies is excluded from the analysis.

GCSE data is only supplied where an applicant has achieved 6 or more GCSEs, since this is then judged to be their main pre-16 qualification.

GCSE grades are now a mixture of the new grades (9-1) and old grades (A*-G).

Other data

GCSE school group is not collected. School group is given for the school from which an applicant made their UCAS application, usually their post-16 school (UCAS apply base).

Where referred to in this report, a "successful" applicant means a candidate who has been offered a place, i.e. an offer holder.
