Your request for information received on 26 April 2017 has now been considered and the information requested is as follows:

1. *your policy or policy guidance for duties under the Counter-Terrorism and Security Act 2015 duties for the various local authorities listed in Schedule 6, known as "Prevent";*

2. *your policy relating to Internet filtering, blocking and prevention of access to material deemed inappropriate;*

A firewall policy using the Palo alto "Extremism" filtering category is in use and set to block access to sites within the category. Palo alto firewall "Extremism" policy description. "Websites promoting terrorism, racism, fascism or other extremist views discriminating people or groups of different ethnic backgrounds, religions or other beliefs."

3. *the name of any providers of Internet filtering and blocking services that you use*

Palo Alto firewall URL filtering as described in (2)

4. *a list of agreements, arrangements or Memorandums of Understanding between yourselves and bodies such as the Internet Watch Foundation and the Counter Terrorism Internet Referral Unit of the Metropolitan Police Service (MPS) to receive lists of illegal content, for instance for the purposes of blocking.*

No direct agreements or arrangements are currently in place with the above listed organisations.
