Thank you for your email of 31 March.

We consider that you have raised and we have answered this question previously and accordingly we are not obliged to comply with a repeated request in reliance upon section 14(2) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Your question was originally raised on the 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2017 with clarification provided as to scope on 21<sup>st</sup> June 2017 and our response was given to you on 18<sup>th</sup> July 2017 under reference 752,498, we would refer you to this response.

We would also make comment that following our response you raised this question or the elements of it that you were not satisfied as a formal complaint with the Information Commissioner's Office on the 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2018 reference FS50703073.

Further responses and clarification was given to the ICO Senior Case Office at that time and upon your failing to respond to the ICO the case was closed by the ICO on the 4<sup>th</sup> September 2018.
