### **FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT (FOIA) REQUEST – 190102005**

Thank you for your email of 2 January in which you asked for the following information from the Ministry of Justice (MoJ):

#### **Can I please have a copy of HMPPS's PETP?**

Your request has been handled under the FOIA 2000. Although there is no Prison Estate Transformation Programme (PETP) document as such I have enclosed two leaflets about the work of the programme and the PETP operator competition services brochure, which were published towards the end of last year.

Through PETP we are getting the basics right by building decent prisons to improve rehabilitation and create safe and secure environments for staff and offenders. The department is committed to delivering up to 10,000 decent prison places providing the physical conditions for Governors to achieve better educational, training and rehabilitative outcomes.

As well as constructing new prisons we are reconfiguring the existing estate so that men will be held in the right place at the right time in their custodial journey to support their rehabilitation.
