THE GLA ROAD (RED ROUTE) TRAFFIC ORDERS GENERAL VARIATION ORDER 2007

- 1. Transport for London, hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
- **2.** The general nature and effect of this Variation Order would be to exempt, from existing Red Route no-stopping controls, private hire vehicles (mini-cabs) whilst they pick up or drop off passengers.
- **3.** The roads which would be affected by this Variation Order would be all roads in Greater London that are covered by Red Route (red line) controls.
- **4.** A copy of the Order, a statement of Transport for London's reasons for the proposals and copies of any Order revoked, suspended or varied by the Order can be inspected during normal office hours at the offices of:

- 5. All objections and other representations to the proposed Order must be made in writing and must specify the grounds on which they are made.
