FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST

Your correspondence dated 7 February 2013 has been considered to be a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000. You requested the following information:

Please could you supply me with the date of production for the batch / batches of depleted uranium, acquired from the USA, that have been used in the manufacturing of CHARM3.

I am writing to advise you that following a search of our paper and electronic records, I have established that the information you requested is not held by the Ministry of Defence.

If you are not satisfied with this response or you wish to complain about any aspect of the handling of your request, then you should contact me in the first instance. If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
