Further to your email of 29 January, I am contacting you to see if there is any update on the revised scheduled.

I am conscious that both residents and Members have been chasing for progress updates as to the status of Mr Dorfman's report and when it is likely to be completed.

It has now been more than three months since Mr Dorfman said he was unable to complete his report for the special Audit Committee meeting on 12 February and I am concerned there has been a lack of updates since this point in time. Furthermore, it is my understanding that some of the residents in this email and Councillors at Great Linford Parish Council have still not been able to speak to Mr Dorfman, despite contacting him in October/November 2019.

I think it would be useful for all parties if the Council could provide a formal update as to the status of Mr Dorfman's review and when it is likely to be completed. Even though we are currently in a difficult period with the lockdown, I believe there is no reason why he could not continue to complete his review and conduct any interviews or meetings remotely.
