Thank you for your Freedom of Information (FOI) review request, which we received on 11/10/2017.

You have asked us:

This matter is now live with the Information Commissioner ref FS50687258.

We refer to the date as a 'review date'. It is a database field which the DWP have on every claimant record which tells them when the claimant is due to be assessed by a Work Capability assessor such as Maximus. A 'healthcare professional' at a place such as Maximus would write a report and send it onto a DWP 'decision maker' who would state whether the claimant is fit for work (or not).

We asked for a document containing this date referred to above which would provide proof to a pharmacist that the claimant is in current receipt of a benefit such as Employment and Support Allowance thus entitled to free prescriptions. What DWP provided was not what we asked for.

It is not the case that the DWP don't have this information because we know they hold it on the record of each claimant. They have thus far failed to provide us with any document containing that specific field.

DWP Response:

I am of a senior grade to the person who dealt with your request, I was not involved previously, and can confirm that I have carried out an internal review. I am now in a position to respond to you.

I am content that your original request was dealt with in accordance with DWP guidelines for FoI requests.
