In response to your recent request for information regarding;

1. The Location (incl. Full address & Postcode) of all buildings occupied by your organisation.

This information is publicly available on our Police and Crime Commissioners website; https://www.northwales-pcc.gov.uk/en/Information/Lists-and-Registers.aspx

There is also 1 remaining police house which is excluded from the list as it is a private residence for a serving police officer.

There are 2 buildings in Buckley and Bodhyfryd, Wrexham which are not on the list as they are now unoccupied and subject to disposal.

2. The tenure (i.e. Leasehold or Freehold) of all building occupied by your organisation.

10 leasehold buildings. The remaining are freehold buildings.

3. Whether any of these buildings are subject to PFI Agreements.

One PFI contract for the St Asaph LPS HQ building.

4. The use (i.e. Police Station/Neighbourhood Base/Offices/Disused) of all buildings occupied by your organisations.

This can be seen from the description of each building in the list under Q1. If there is no specific designation it is an administration building.

There are 2 buildings in Buckley and Bodhyfryd, Wrexham which are not on the list and are now disused.

5. The identity of any locations that are earmarked for future disposal.

Currently being reviewed as part of the Estate Strategy 2018-2028 – also on the PCC website, link in Question 1 and would be subject to the endorsement of the PCC and Chief Officers.

6. The date at which any future disposals are due to take place.

During the next 2 to 3 years.

7. Whether any of these locations will be replaced after disposal.

The Estate Strategy proposes a more agile working model for some locations e.g. working from fire stations.

8. If a replacement location is intended, what form will this take (i.e. Relocation/Co-Location).

To be decided but co-location in fire stations where feasible is the preferred model.
