The City of Westminster Pension Fund invests in two pooled property funds; Hermes Property Unit Trust (£63,073,285.40 at 31st March 2019) and Standard Life Long Lease Fund (£64,708,543.23 at 31st March 2019) The Fund does not hold any direct real estate assets or real estate debt funds.

2) The current yields of the different investments the pension fund holds.

For the year to 31st March 2019 the rate of return of the Standard Life Long Lease Property Fund was 6.92% gross of fees and 6.81% gross of fees for the Hermes Property Unit Trust Fund.

3) Can you clearly specify the total value of all real estate investments that the Pension Fund holds.

The market value of our real estate holdings at 31st March 2019 was as follows; Hermes - £63,073,285.40 and Standard Life - £64,708,543.23.
