

## THE BOROUGH OF BLACKBURN

### APPOINTMENT OF STANDS FOR HACKNEY CARRIAGES

The Blackburn Borough Council, pursuant to the provisions of Section 63 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976, having given the notices required by section 63 (2) and having considered any objections or representations, and with the consent of the Lancashire County Council as highway authority, hereby appoint stands for hackney carriages, as listed below, and revoke previously appointed stands for hackney carriages, also as listed below.

#### STANDS APPOINTED

The hackney carriage stands to be appointed are situated on Church Street, Blackburn, and on Fleming Square, Blackburn, as specified in Schedule 1 below. The stand on Fleming Square will be operative between the hours of 2100 and 0300 only.

The appointment of hackney carriage stands, situated on Grosvenor Way, Blackburn and on King William Street, Blackburn, and as specified in Schedule 2 below, is hereby revoked.

Fleming Square	North	From the western boundary of 2 Fleming Square for a distance of approximately 20 metres in a westerly direction.

King William Street	West	Layby between its junction with Town Hall Street and its junction with Exchange Street.
Grosvenor Way	West	From its junction with Church Street for a distance of approximately 30 metres in a northerly direction.

Made under section 68 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 and Section 171 of The Public Health Act 1875 by the Borough of Blackburn acting by the Council with respect to hackney carriages in the former County Borough of Blackburn.

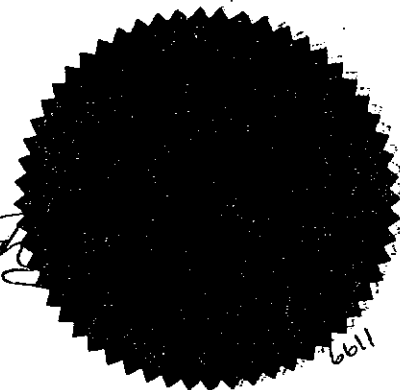
Byelaw 18 of the series of byelaws made by the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Blackburn acting by the Council on the 20th day of September 1972 and confirmed by one of Her Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State on the 22nd day of December 1972 is hereby repealed and replaced by the following byelaw, which shall be read and construed as one with the series made by the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses acting by the Council on the 4th day of June 1951, and confirmed by one of the Principal Secretaries of State of His Late Majesty King George VI on the 31st day of July, 1951:-

18. Each of the several places specified in the following list shall be a stand for such numbers of hackney carriages as is specified in the list

✓ 1	Railway Road alongside Blackburn Railway Station in the space specially provided	8
2	Grosvenor Way, East Side, adjacent to the Woolworth's Store	6
3	St. Peter Street, South Side. Carriages to stand against the kerb to face towards Mincing Lane. (Not more than 95 feet and not less than 30 feet from the building line of Darwen Street). To be used only between the hours of 11.15 p.m. and 6.00 a.m.	4
