Freedom of Information Act 2000 request: AAC Provision

With reference to your request for information, dated 20 January, made under section 1(1) of the Freedom of Information Act, I am writing to inform you that the information you require exists and is included in this letter.

You asked the following:

"Could you please send me details of augmentative and alternative communication devices purchased by, or on behalf of your trust between 31st March 2006 and 1st April 2011?"

Central London Community Healthcare (CLCH) achieved NHS Trust status on 1 November 2010, having been confirmed as a single autonomous provider organisation by NHS London in March 2009. Before this, the provider arms at the Primary Care Trusts (PCT) of Westminster, Hammersmith & Fulham, and Kensington & Chelsea existed independently. Services from NHS Barnet joined the Trust on 1 April 2011.

The information provided therefore covers the period 1 November 2010 to 1 April 2011 and is attached to the rear of this letter. The information is not available in the format that you requested, but I have provided what I hope is sufficient enough detail for you to identify the products and which of your categories they fit into.

This completes our response to your request for information. Please accept my apologies for the delay in providing you with a response.
