Good morning Pam,

I am writing to challenge and appeal against the council's decision to hold the 'informal council' meeting on Thursday, May 20 in private.

Having read the constitution I can find nothing which says this meeting may be held in private.

Indeed, Article 3 states citizens have the right to "attend the Council Meeting and meetings of Committees and Sub-Committees except where confidential matters are being discussed".

Article 4 defines the Council Meeting as "a meeting to which all members of the Council have been called, constituted and conducted in accordance with this Constitution".

That clearly includes the annual meeting and, in the view of legal advice I have sought, the informal meeting - particularly as the constitution states that is where the debate will take place and that its decisions will be ratified at the annual meeting without debate.

I refer to your email to Pam Smith, the Council's Chief Executive of 18 May 2021 at 17.04 requesting a response by 11.00 on Wednesday 19 May 2021. As you will appreciate this unilaterally imposed timescale demanding a response within less than 2 working hours' is completely unreasonable.

I am the Council's Monitoring Officer and Strategic Head of Service (Legal and Democratic Governance) and am responding on the Chief Executive's behalf due to the (entirely unwarranted) threats of legal proceedings contained in your email.

Not only is the tone of your email wholly inappropriate, your claims are without foundation. It would appear that you are writing under several misapprehensions and misunderstandings (set out below) and as such your correspondence is premature and unnecessary:-

- 1. the Chief Executive has not made any decision to refuse access to the press or public to the meeting on 20 May 2021;
- 2. as stated to your colleague by email yesterday, the decision rests with the members attending the informal council meeting as to whether the press and public can attend via webcast. There are ongoing discussions in respect of that between members. In the event that an agreement is not reached prior to the meeting then the inclusion of the press and public will be the first item on the agenda for the meeting on 20 May 2021 for discussion and decision;
- 3. however, as previously stated, as the meeting is an informal meeting, not convened under the 1972 Act, or any other legislation, it is not open to the public or the press as of right (like many other informal meetings that take place at the Council between members and/or officers). It is not a decision making body. The Annual Council Meeting on 25 May 2021 will be webcast and is where the decisions will be made that were discussed on 20 May 2021. This process is certainly not "anti-democratic and secretive" but is part of the Council's Constitution which is agreed (and adopted) by all 63 members at the start of each municipal year.
- your references to various legislation are incorrect and not relevant as they relate to meetings of decision making bodies; the informal council meeting is not a decision making body;
- your reference to the Cabinet Meeting of the Kensington & Chelsea Borough Council is again not relevant as that was a meeting of the Cabinet formally convened pursuant to statute which the Council sought to exclude the public from and hold in private.

Finally, I note your reference to making an application to the High Court (in respect of a decision which currently rests with members) in respect of which the Council's rights remain reserved and in respect of which we put you on notice that our costs will be

sought from you on an indemnity basis should you choose to (misguidedly) proceed in that way, together with a wasted costs order.

Paragraph 3. "Subject to regulation 4, a meeting of a decision-making body must be held in public."

None of the exceptions in regulation 4 apply in this instance

I understand that a motion will be moved, debated and voted upon regarding a new council leader. Therefore, it will be our submission as a meeting of a decision body,

It is vital in a free and democratic society that the decisions and discussions of elected officials are open to public scrutiny.

I refer to your email to Pam Smith, the Council's Chief Executive of 18 May 2021 at 17.04 requesting a response by 11.00 on Wednesday 19 May 2021. As you will appreciate this unilaterally imposed timescale demanding a response within less than 2 working hours' is completely unreasonable.

I am the Council's Monitoring Officer and Strategic Head of Service (Legal and Democratic Governance) and am responding on the Chief Executive's behalf due to the (entirely unwarranted) threats of legal proceedings contained in your email.

Not only is the tone of your email wholly inappropriate, your claims are without foundation. It would appear that you are writing under several misapprehensions and misunderstandings (set out below) and as such your correspondence is premature and unnecessary:-

- 1. the Chief Executive has not made any decision to refuse access to the press or public to the meeting on 20 May 2021;
- 2. as stated to your colleague by email yesterday, the decision rests with the members attending the informal council meeting as to whether the press and public can attend via webcast. There are ongoing discussions in respect of that between members. In the event that an agreement is not reached prior to the meeting then the inclusion of the press and public will be

the first item on the agenda for the meeting on 20 May 2021 for discussion and decision:

- 3. however, as previously stated, as the meeting is an informal meeting, not convened under the 1972 Act, or any other legislation, it is not open to the public or the press as of right (like many other informal meetings that take place at the Council between members and/or officers). It is not a decision making body. The Annual Council Meeting on 25 May 2021 will be webcast and is where the decisions will be made that were discussed on 20 May 2021. This process is certainly not "anti-democratic and secretive" but is part of the Council's Constitution which is agreed (and adopted) by all 63 members at the start of each municipal year.
- your references to various legislation are incorrect and not relevant as they relate to meetings of decision making bodies; the informal council meeting is not a decision making body;
- 5. your reference to the Cabinet Meeting of the Kensington & Chelsea Borough Council is again not relevant as that was a meeting of the Cabinet formally convened pursuant to statute which the Council sought to exclude the public from and hold in private.

Finally, I note your reference to making an application to the High Court (in respect of a decision which currently rests with members) in respect of which the Council's rights remain reserved and in respect of which we put you on notice that our costs will be sought from you on an indemnity basis should you choose to (misguidedly) proceed in that way, together with a wasted costs order.
