 - c. the assessment outcomes in relation to University of Wolverhampton's grievance and disciplinary policies for staff and similarly in regard to complaints investigation procedures relating to students?
 - d. the number of racial discrimination complaints /allegations /notifications brought by students over the past three academic years 2018/19, 2017/18, 2016/17
 - e. the number of those claims at point (d) that proceeded to a full disciplinary investigation and the decision outcomes of those procedures please?
 - f. in regard to new GDPR legislation, since 2018 how many University staff within The School of Media have been disciplined, for failing to meet the University's obligations under GDPR 2018 legislation to date?
 - g. how many race discrimination claims has the university received over the past three academic years?
