Dear Mr Ashby

Following my email to you dated 27 January regarding RAF Officers Court Martials, it has now come to our attention that some information provided to you was incorrect.

A corrected list of RAF Officer Courts Martial can be found at Annex A, but I have summarised the amendments below:

- 1. The details of one entry for a Flight Lieutenant in 2008 was incorrectly listed as "3 charges of Neglect in Performing a Duty, 2 charges of Sexual Assault on a Child under 13, and 1 charge of failing to make an entry in an official document with the intent to deceive", this should have read "1 charge of prohibited low flying contrary to Regulation 5(3)(e) of the Rules of the Air Regulation 2007", the outcome for this entry has also been corrected.
- 2. In 2005, the Flying Officer's plea had been recorded as Guilty, this should have read Not Guilty.
- 3. An additional case in 2006 has been included at Annex A, this relates to 5 charges of Failed to Attend.

Please accept my apologies for these mistakes; the information that you had requested was supplied from a database, which is regularly updated from Court Martial case notes, and not directly from Court Martial files. Some information provided from the database had been mistakenly recorded; in order to ensure that all other details are correct, the remaining charges and sentences since 2004 have been double-checked and cross-referred with the case files, and I can confirm that all other details previously provided are correct. Case files are not routinely held for longer than 6 years, therefore, cases prior to 2004 have not been cross-referred with the Court Martial files.



As with the original document sent to you, in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998 (DPA 98), section 2(g) and 2(h), the names of individuals have been withheld as this type of information is classed as third party personal data. As such, under section 40 of the FOI Act (Information that constitutes personal data of which the applicant is not the data subject), the RAF is not permitted to release this information as it would contravene the Data Protection Principles set out in the Schedule to the DPA 98.

The information supplied to you continues to be protected by the Copyright, Designs and Patents Act 1988. You are free to use it for your own purposes, including any non-commercial research you are doing and for the purposes of news reporting. Any other reuse, for example commercial publication, would require the permission of the copyright holder.
