Dear Mr Cooper

Thank you for your e-mail of 18 April 2013 asking if any radioactive equipment has been unaccounted for by the RAF (including X-ray equipment) between 1 February 1960 and 1 March 1961. This has been considered as a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

Having researched your question through various Ministry of Defence departments, including Air Historic Branch, I can confirm that the information you have requested is not held by the department. As the records you requested are over 50 years old you may wish to try contacting the National Archives who hold MOD historic records, but it is also possible that some records from that long ago have been destroyed. If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
