# (30 MPH, 40 MPH, 50 MPH AND DERESTRICTED SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 2009

THE DERBYSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Section 84(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

#### 1 CITATION AND COMMENCEMENT

This Order may be cited as "The Derbyshire County Council (A6 Newtown, Bridgemont/Furness Vale, Chapel en le Frith, Doveholes, Buxton, Taddington, Bakewell, Rowsley, Darley Dale, Matlock, Matlock Bath, Cromford, Homesford Cottage and Ambergate) (30 mph, 40 mph, 50 mph and Derestricted Speed Limits) Order 2009 and shall come into force on the Thirtieth day of March Two thousand and Nine.

#### 2 INTERPRETATION

"Motor vehicle" means a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on roads.

#### 3 SPEED RESTRICTION

3.1 No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.

- 3.2 No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
- 3.3 No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 3 to this Order.
- 3.4 No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding the Derestricted Speed Limit on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 4 to this Order.

#### 4 REVOCATION OF PREVIOUS ORDER

The Derbyshire County Council (A6 Newtown to Ambergate) (30 mph, 40 mph, 50 mph and Derestricted Speed Limits) Order 2008 is hereby revoked in its entirety.

## SCHEDULE 1

# 30 MPH SPEED LIMITS

#### **A6 NEWTOWN**

From a point 40 metres (44 yards) South East of its Junction with Goyt View to the County Boundary with Cheshire.

#### A6 (BRIDGEMONT/FURNESS VALE)

From a point 75 metres (82 yards) South East of the centre point of the Bothomes Hall Roundabout, Bridgemont to a point 522 metres (571 yards) South East of its Junction with Goyt View, Newtown.

#### A6 DOVEHOLES

From a point 618 metres (676 yards) South of its Junction with Station Road to a point 200 metres (219 yards) North of its Junction with Beelow Close.

#### **A6 BUXTON**

From a point 30 metres (33 yards) South East of its Junction with Dukes Drive to a point 210 metres (230 yards) North East of its Junction with North Road.

#### <u>A6 BAKEWELL</u>

From a point 95 metres (104 yards) North of its Junction with Mill Street to a point 55 metres (60 yards) South East of Burton Close Drive.

#### **A6 ROWSLEY**

From a point 80 metres (87 yards) South of Chatsworth Road to a point 115 metres (126 yards) West of its Junction with Church Lane.

#### A6 DARLEY DALE (NORTHWOOD)

From a point 570 metres (623 yards) North West of Church Road/Derwent View to a point 123 metres (135 yards) North West of its Junction with Northwood Lane.

#### A6 DARLEY DALE

From a point 66 metres (72 yards) South East of Warney Road to a point 12 metres (13 yards) North West of its Junction with Church Road/Derwent View.

#### A6 MATLOCK

From a point 500 metres (547 yards) North West of its Junction with Dimple Road to a point 119 metres (130 yards) North of the Bridge over the River Derwent leading to Pic Tor Lane, Matlock.

#### A6 MATLOCK BATH

From a point 353 metres (386 yards) North of its Junction with Station Road/North Parade, Matlock Bath to a point 18 metres (20 yards) South of its Junction with Clifton Road.

#### A6 DERBY ROAD, AMBERGATE

From a point 142 metres (155 yards) North of its Junction with Devonshire Street to a point 165 metres (180 yards) South of its Junction with West Bank.

## SCHEDULE 2

## **40 MPH SPEED LIMITS**

#### **A6 NEWTOWN TO FURNESS VALE**

From a point 522 metres (571 yards) South East of its Junction with Goyt View, Newtown to a point 40 metres (44 yards) South East of that Junction.

#### **A6 BUXTON ROAD, BAKEWELL**

From a point 95 metres (104 yards) North of Mill Street to a point 285 metres (312 yards) West of its Junction with Vernon Green.

#### A6 HADDON ROAD, BAKEWELL

From a point 55 metres (60 yards) South East of Burton Close Drive to a point 152 metres South of Intake Lane.

#### A6 DARLEY DALE

From a point 12 metres (13 yards) North West of its Junction with Church Road/ Derwent View to a point 570 metres (623 yards) North West of that Junction.

#### A6 MATLOCK TO DARLEY DALE

From a point 500 metres (547 yards) North West of its Junction with Dimple Road, Matlock to a point 66 metres (72 yards) South East of Warney Road, Darley Dale.

#### A6 DALE ROAD (MATLOCK BATH TO MATLOCK)

From a point 353 metres (386 yards) North of its Junction with Station Road/North Parade, Matlock Bath to a point 119 metres (130 yards) North of the Bridge over the River Derwent leading to Pic Tor Lane, Matlock.

#### A6 DERBY ROAD (CROMFORD TO MATLOCK BATH)

From a point 165 metres (180 yards) South East of its Junction with Intake Lane, Cromford to a point 18 metres (20 yards) South of its Junction with Clifton Road.

#### **A6 HOMESFORD COTTAGE**

From a point 103 metres (113 yards) South East of the Junction with the access to Homesford Cottage to a point 150 metres (164 yards) North West of the access to Homesford Cottage.

#### A6 DERBY ROAD/MATLOCK ROAD, AMBERGATE

From a point 142 metres (155 yards) North of its Junction with Devonshire Street to a point 207 metres (226 yards) North of its Junction with Chase Road.

# SCHEDULE 3

## **50 MPH SPEED LIMITS**

#### A6 DOVEHOLES TO CHAPEL EN LE FRITH

From a point 200 metres (219 yards) North of its Junction with Beelow Close, Doveholes to a point 230 metres (252 yards) South of the Junction with the B5470 at Chapel en le Frith.

#### A6 BUXTON TO DOVEHOLES

From a point 210 metres (230 yards) North East of its Junction with North Road, Buxton to a point 618 metres (676 yards) South of its Junction with Station Road, Doveholes.

#### **A6 TADDINGTON TO BUXTON**

From a point 80 metres (87 yards) East of its Junction with School Lane, Taddington to a point 30 metres (33 yards) South East of its Junction with Dukes Drive, Buxton.

### A6 BAKEWELL TO TADDINGTON

From a point 285 metres (312 yards) West of its Junction with Vernon Green, Bakewell to a point 17 metres (19 yards) East of its Junction with Main Street, Taddington.

#### A6 ROWSLEY TO BAKEWELL

From a point 115 metres (126 yards) West of its Junction with Church Lane, Rowsley to a point 152 metres (166 yards) South of Intake Lane, Bakewell.

#### A6 DALE ROAD NORTH (ROWSLEY TO NORTHWOOD, DARLEY DALE)

From a point 80 metres (87 yards) South of Chatsworth Road, Rowsley to a point 123 metres (135 yards) North West of its Junction with Northwood Lane, Northwood, Darley Dale.

#### A6 CROMFORD TO HOMESFORD COTTAGE

From a point 165 metres (180 yards) South East of its Junction with Intake Lane, Cromford to a point 150 metres (164 yards) North West of the access to Homesford Cottage.

#### A6 AMBERGATE TO HOMESFORD COTTAGE

From a point 207 metres (226 yards) North of its Junction with Chase Road, Ambergate to a point 103 metres (113 yards) South East of the Junction with the access to Homesford Cottage.

### SCHEDULE 4

# DERESTRICTED SPEED LIMITS

#### A6 CHAPEL EN LE FRITH TO BRIDGEMONT

From a point 230 metres (252 yards) South of the Junction with the B5470 at Chapel en le Frith to a point 75 metres (82 yards) South East of the Centre Point of the Bothomes Hall Roundabout, Bridgemont.

#### **A6 TADDINGTON BYPASS**

From a point 17 metres (19 yards) East of its Junction with Main Street to a point 80 metres (87 yards) East of its Junction with School Lane.
