I have been a Marlborough Town Councillor for sixteen years and have sat on many planning application. I could write to you giving all of the normal Core Strategy Policy and NPPF reasons for turning down this application but I feel that you will have many of such letters and I will be just one of many repeating a mantra.

So may I make a heart felt appeal to you to turn this application down .My reasons are these; time and time again I hear Councillors and Planning Officers in good faith applying conditions to planning applications which all believe will be upheld.

To have any credence people in our position must be seen to uphold and enforce the conditions imposed when a proposal is passed. People already have a very lowly opinion of both Planning Authorities and Councillors which is hard to combat.

When the Rogers Meadows estate was built the Planning Authority put in a condition that the land now subject to this planning application would be safe guarded **IN PERPETURITY AS A PLAY AREA/OPEN SPACE** this estate was quickly followed by the Rabbley Wood View estate and the Thorns estates all three estates had to share this open space/play area. The same promise was made for all three estates. It seems now that the English language is now open to different interpretations by an unscrupulous few. **IN PERPETURITY SURLY MEANS FOR EVER.** We must be able to trust the English language and also may I add the authority that uses it to reassure us. I feel that to change that promise made in good faith would demean all that endeavour to uphold good and honest planning law and devalue the whole process.
