- I would like to know what data you record about the rate of recalls that you see in those to whom you grant parole; please provide this by year if it is available.
- Is there a target or set of targets for this?
- Who set this (a minister, a court, the board)?
- Is it used to offer feedback to board members about the 'accuracy' of their decisions, either overall or even as individuals?
