
Dear Mr Smith

Thank you for your email to the IPCC dated 2 November 2017 in which you complain that your information request 1006729 has not been dealt with promptly and therefore there has been a breach of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) section 10.

Section 10 of the FOIA states that a public authority must comply with a valid request promptly and no later than the twentieth working day following date of receipt. Your information request (1006729) was received on the 5 October. It was received by the Information Rights Team and allocated to the business directorate within the IPCC who held the information you had requested. This directorate managed your information request along with their workload and provided the information to you within nineteen working days.
