A request for review should be submitted within 40 working days of either the date on which you received a response from the University or the date by which you should have received a response under the terms of the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002, whichever is the later.

Requests for information held by other public authorities and any complaints regarding access to such information should be addressed to that authority.
