I am writing to confirm that the Housing Executive has now completed its search for the information and can advise that the Housing Executive does not hold this information as a 'specific plan B' regarding the emptying of bins in the case of industrial action does not exist in our records.

However I would advise you while the aforementioned industrial action has finished the emptying of bins will always remain the responsibility of Lisburn City Council as they are tasked with waste management. However we would review and investigate on a case by case basis if such a matter arose again.
