Dear Mr Beckles,

I refer to your email of 3 June 2009 in which you ask for a copy of Paper ISG2 ('The Report and the responses to the consultation') to which reference was made in the documentation which we supplied to you on 3 June 2009 in response to your request of 5 May 2009.

I attach this document. Certain information has been withheld (redacted) on the ground that it is exempt under section 40 (personal information) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000. Section 40(2) provides that personal data is exempt information if one of the conditions set out in section 40(3) is satisfied and in this case disclosure of the information in question would contravene the fair processing principle contained in the Data Protection Act (DPA), where it would be unfair to that person/is confidential.
