*Thank you for your response to my request for information, however now that I have some of the information it is clear I require an earlier revision as indicated below for some of the documents since the tents I own are of the earlier Canvas type and not the newer PVC variants documented.*

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence (MOD), and I can confirm that some information in scope of your request is held and is attached to the email.

The information you have requested has been found, but some of the information falls entirely within the scope of the absolute exemption provided for at section 40 (Personal Data) of the FOIA and has been redacted.

Section 40(2) has been applied to some of the information in order to protect personal information as governed by the Data Protection Act 1998. Section 40 is an absolute exemption and there is therefore no requirement to consider the public interest in making a decision to withhold the information.

Under Section 16 of the Act (Advice and Assistance) you may find it helpful to note that the MOD could not locate the 2<sup>nd</sup> edition of 8340-C-116-741, consequently I have included the 1<sup>st</sup> edition of that publication.
