






I've filled in some gaps...

The population and boundary area currently supplied from the Ennerdale and Cornhow water treatment works will be the same population (70,000 properties) as supplied with fluoridated water from the Williamsgate water treatment works with the exception of some properties within Buttermere. The domestic water supply for Buttermere has until 2018 been supplied by a separate water treatment works at Buttermere using Sail Beck as the water source. The plant equipment is no longer fit for purpose and supply was switched to Ennerdale in 2018.

The number of properties that will be added is 40 and is therefore less than 20%.

I've added the section in yellow as a clarification. For information, there will be three outlets from Williamsgate WTW – two of the legs will be fluoridated and these will supply the areas previously supplied from Ennerdale and Cornhow. However, there will be a separate leg leaving the Williamsgate WTW that will not be fluoridated that will supply the Quarry Hill WTW supply area (this area has never been fluoridated).

With regards to operable and efficient – we sent a letter confirming that the scheme will be operable and efficient (attached), signed by the Area Business Manager who will be responsible for the operation of Williamsgate WTW. Please let me know if you need anything further.
