

CAMBRIDGESHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(CAMBRIDGE ROAD(A603), HARLTON AND LT. EVERSDEEN)
(50 MPH SPEED LIMIT)
ORDER 2014

The Cambridgeshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 84(1) and 84(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on any of the roads and lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemption (Special Forces) (Variation Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
3. This Order may be cited as the "Cambridgeshire County Council (Cambridge Road(A603), Harlton and Lt. Eversden) (50mph Speed Limit) Order 2014" and shall come into operation on the 18th day of August 2014.
