I refer to your request for information received on 20 May 2019 regarding:

Given that the council is now consulting publicly on growth plans for the Borough in its Local Plan I believe it is in the public interest for the pages previously withheld now to be disclosed if they relate in any way to growth that may occur in the Borough”

The response to your question is below:

We attach a copy of the minutes with the paragraph now available. This was previously withheld because of its reference to the Development Capacity Study, which is now in the public domain and published on the Council's website.

With regards to the page withheld from the 5 April 2016, we do not hold this information as the document belongs to the GLA.
