Internal review requests should be submitted within two months of the date of receipt of the response to your original enquiry.

Your request must be in a recordable format (letter, email, audio tape, etc.). You will receive a full response to your request for review within 20 working days of its receipt.

If you are not content with the outcome of the internal review, you have the right to apply directly to English Information Commissioner to review our decision.

You must submit your complaint to the Commissioner within six months of receiving the response to review letter. The Commissioner's Office may be contacted as follows:
