I just wanted to let you know that we are publishing our consultation paper next Tuesday. To maximise the time you have to coordinate the police response, I could send you an advance version via email, if that would be helpful. We also intend to send you some hard copies. Is there a postal address we could send them to? I also wanted to let you know that we are planning to have our symposium on Tuesday 8th September and it
