#### **Appendix**

## **Relevant exceptions**

The exceptions that apply to the withheld information are:

The Environment Agency is not able to disclose the names of private individuals as this is personal data under the Data Protection Act 1998 (DPA) and to disclose it would breach the First Data Protection Principle of the DPA.

The information requested is therefore exempt due to Regulation 13(1) of the Environmental Information Regulations 2004, which explains that:

"To the extent that the information requested includes personal data of which the applicant is not the data subject and as respects which either the first or second condition below is satisfied, a public authority shall not disclose the personal data".

The 'first condition' referred to above is further explained in Regulation 13(2)(a):

"...in a case where the information falls within any of paragraphs (a) to (d) of the definition of "data" in section 1(1) of the Data Protection Act 1998, that the disclosure of the information to a member of the public otherwise than under these Regulations would contravene—

i) any of the data protection principles...".

The First Data Protection Principle requires that we are fair to individuals when we collect and use their personal data. In this case it would be unfair to disclose information relating to an identifiable individual as such individuals have a reasonable expectation that any information held about them by the Environment Agency would remain confidential.

If you are not satisfied with our decision not to supply the requested information you can contact us to ask for our decision to be reviewed. If you are still not satisfied following this, you can then make an appeal to the Information Commissioner, who is the statutory regulator for Freedom of Information.
