Thank you for your request of 15 September 2019, in which you asked for information about an incident at Gibbs Crescent on 14 February 2017 (Incident No. 050464-14022017).

Please see below your original questions along with our responses (in bold):

1. I would like to obtain the fire incident report and the summary fire report of a blast at Gibbs Crescent flats OX2 0NX which occurred on 14th of February 2017. **Please see attached incident report.**
2. I believe that the summary fire report for this incident includes the attending Crews prior to the attendance of a fire investigation officer, and all the relevant risk assessment documents during the incident. **The details of the attending appliances are detailed in the incident report. This does not include the names of the firefighters who attended as we do not collect this data. Please see the attached two PDF documents containing the ARAs (Analytical Risk Assessments).**
