- If a flat, what cladding was used? (Where applicable)
- Date of Construction
- If property is of Non-Traditional construction (Where applicable i.e. Wimpey No Fines, Airey)
- If any property is Non-Traditional construction, has a repair certificate been issued and if so what was the data of issue? (Where Applicable)
- If the property is ex-Local Authority (Where applicable)

Answer:

The Council does not hold the information you have requested. This is because in 2006 the Council transferred its housing stock to Green Vale Homes (Together Housing) who now operate a choice-based letting scheme on our behalf.
