Freedom of Information request 1715: Non- traditional built properties

I write in reply to your above request regarding non-traditional built properties owned by the Council.

1. The following properties were 'Airey' concrete houses renovated by the Council in the late 1980's using a government approved method of repair (unfortunately we do not have the repair certificates): -
 - 2, 4 & 6 Arden Mead Cottages, Tandridge Lane, Lingfield Surrey
 - 2, 3, 5 & 7 Beeches Mead Cottages, Dormansland Surrey
 - 12 & 14 Little Collins, Outwood Surrey
 - 9 St George Cottages, Crowhurst Lane, Crowhurst, Surrey
 - 4 Homefield Cottage, Church Road, Horne, Surrey
2. The following properties are 'Swedish Timber Homes' that were renovated in 2009 / 10 in accordance with the decent homes standard:-
 - 4 & 6 Claridges Mead, Racecourse Road, Lingfield
 - 1, 2, 4 & 5 Little Collins, Millers Lane, Outwood, Surrey

Please note that adjoining properties to those listed above have been sold by the Council in the last twenty years under the 'Right to Buy' scheme.
