over the yard area of WRWA I could see a very tall street light with 2 lights at the top, there were 2 bright sodium yellow lightsthat were in direct line of sightfrom comps window. I then witnessed in comps bedroom which is adjacent to the living room and also looks out towards the lights. With the thick blackout curtains closed there was a bright halo of yellow light comming in around the edges of the curtains. I advised comp that in my opinion it was not a Stat Nuisance, however I did agree that it was a problem and would WRWA on Monday to see if I could negociate a resolution with them to fit some kind of shading to prevent overspill of lighting into her property, comp was OK with this.

Telephone call to I discussed the 3 C19 issus of overspill light glare . He agreed to get his staff to look into the problem over the next couple of days and then get back to me. He asked if I would confirm my request via email.

E-mail sent to C24 Hi ,

Just a quick line to confirm our earlier telephone conversation. I have received complaints about the new lighting on the tall light pole with the twin lights from residents on the floor of Kennet House Enterprise Way. I have visited them and I can confirm that they are indeed adversely affected by overspill light glare. This is causing problems in both living rooms and bedrooms. I would ask if at all possible that some form of directional shading is fitted to the lights to resolve this problem.

I thank you for you help and assistance in resolving this issue and look forward to hearing from you soon.

Authority) have put black tape over the lights partially as a temporary measure so the light should reflect downwards and away from the residential properties to the south of Feathers Wharf.

Longer term Cory have ordered shutters which will go on the offending lights in order to ensure they stay reflecting away from Feathers (yet maintain a light source at the transfer station) but the delivery estimate for these is two weeks. They are also looking to change the timer device on the lights so that they can switch off automatically at a reasonable time at night and then come on again in the morning just prior to operations — at present the timer only allows the lights to switch on and then off once a day which would mean no lighting in the mornings.

If you would like to relay this information back to the residents of Kennet House, when the permanent alterations have been made I can provide you with a comprehensive response.
